

Join the Birthday Book Club at Godwin and Highland School



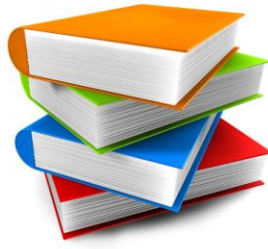
