Authors last name, first name. Title. City of publication: Publisher, Year.

Example:

Rowling, J.K. Harry Potter and the Chamber of Secrets. New York: Scholastic, 1999.

2. Books, with two authors:

Authors last name, first name and second author's first name and last name. Title. City of publication: Publisher, Year.

Example:

Summers, Anthony and Robbyn Swan. Deserts. New York: Knopf, 2005.

3. Encyclopedia, no author listed:

"Title of Article." Title of Encyclopedia. Year Published ed. (ed. = edition)

Example:

"Rain Forest." World Book Encyclopedia of People and Places. 2000 ed.

4. Encyclopedia, with author:

Author's last name, First name. "Title of Article." Title of Encyclopedia. Year Published ed. (ed. = edition)

Example:

Kibby, Michael W. "Oceans." World Book Encyclopedia. 2000 ed.

5. Website, with author listed

Author's last name, first name. "Title of Article or Webpage." Title of Website. Internet. Date you visited the site. (Note: date, month year.)

Example:

Marshall, Leon. "The Coral Reefs: In Danger." National Geographic. Internet. 10 October 2011.

6. World Book Online

Author's last name, first name. "Title of Article or Webpage." Title of Website. Internet. Date you visited the site. (Note: date, month year.)

Example:

Sims, Phillip L. "Savanna." World Book Student. World Book, 2012. Internet. 5 March 2012.

7. Ebsco Database Article from Student Research Center

Author's last name, first name. "Title of Article or Webpage." Title of Website. Internet. Date you visited the site. (Note: date, month year.)

Example:

Aliprandini, Michael, "Our World: Laos." Student Research Center Ebsco. Internet. 19 September 2012.

8. ProQuest/Sir Discoverer

Author's last name, first name. "Title of Article or Webpage." Title of Website. Internet. Date you visited the site. (Note: date, month year.)

Example:

"Laos. SIRS Discoverer: Country Facts. 2012." SIRS Discoverer. Internet. 19 September 2012.
