Would you like lots of people to know that you are one of Midland Park's Summer Reading Stars?

Several organizations in town, the MPPEF, the Midland Park Public Library, and the Highland/Godwin Schools are working together to help you become one of those stars—and to let everyone who drives by your home know what a star reader you are.

What do you have to do to become a Summer Reading Star?

You must get BINGO at least twice anywhere on the boards located on this flyer. Once you complete a reading task in a box, color it in and think about your next reading adventure. Each time you read you can color in a box. We've given you two boards so you have options. The choice is YOURS! To be a Star, you must turn in this form at the MP Public Library by **Friday, August 17, 2018**.

How will you be recognized as a Summer Reading Star?

Turn in this form at the public library and you will be given a special sign to display on your lawn during the summer. You will also receive special recognition when you return to school in September. (Please note: Signs will need to be returned to the library for use in future years.)

Who can be a Midland Park Summer Reading Star?

Any child entering grades K to 6 residing in Midland Park. If you attend a school other than Godwin or Highland School your special recognition certificate will be mailed to your home.
