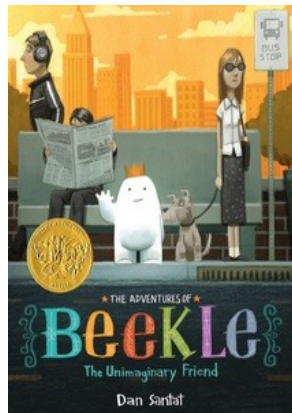
About the Books
