Comprehensive Health and Physical Education is an integral part of your child's educational experience and emphasizes the natural interdisciplinary connections between wellness and health and physical education. The primary focus is the development of knowledge and skills that influence healthy behaviors within the context of self, family, school, and the local and global community.

The 2020 Health and PE standards have been adopted by the Midland Park School District and meet all requirements mandated by the N.J. Department of Education. The Midland Park School District acknowledges that parents/guardians are the primary family life educators for their child(ren) and we are committed to partnering with you to provide Family Life/Sex education to ensure that all of our students have an opportunity to learn about sensitive topics in a safe and structured environment. The Family Life/Sex Education Program at Highland School addresses the following material in the spring of 5<sup>th</sup> grade.

- Personal Growth and Development (puberty)
- Social and Sexual Health (Human Reproduction and Pregnancy)
- Pregnancy and Parenting (Sexual Orientation and Gender Identity)

However, you are encouraged to read the Highland Health curriculum in its entirety, that can be found online, in order to familiarize yourself with all aspects of the Health curriculum.

Although we strongly encourage families to have their child(ren) participate in these essential health topics, we want to acknowledge that as per state statute, <u>Parents/Guardians do have the option of excluding their child from any portion of sexuality/family life education instruction if it is in conflict with their conscience, moral values, or religiously held beliefs.</u>

NJ Statute: Title 18A-Education: Section 18A35-4.7: Parent's statement of conflict with conscience:

Any child whose parent or guardian presents to the school principal a signed statement that any part of the instructions in health, family life education or sex education is in conflict with his conscience, or sincerely held moral or religious beliefs shall be excused from that portion of the course where such instruction is being given and no penalties as to credit or graduation shall result therefrom.
